## DIRECTIONS:

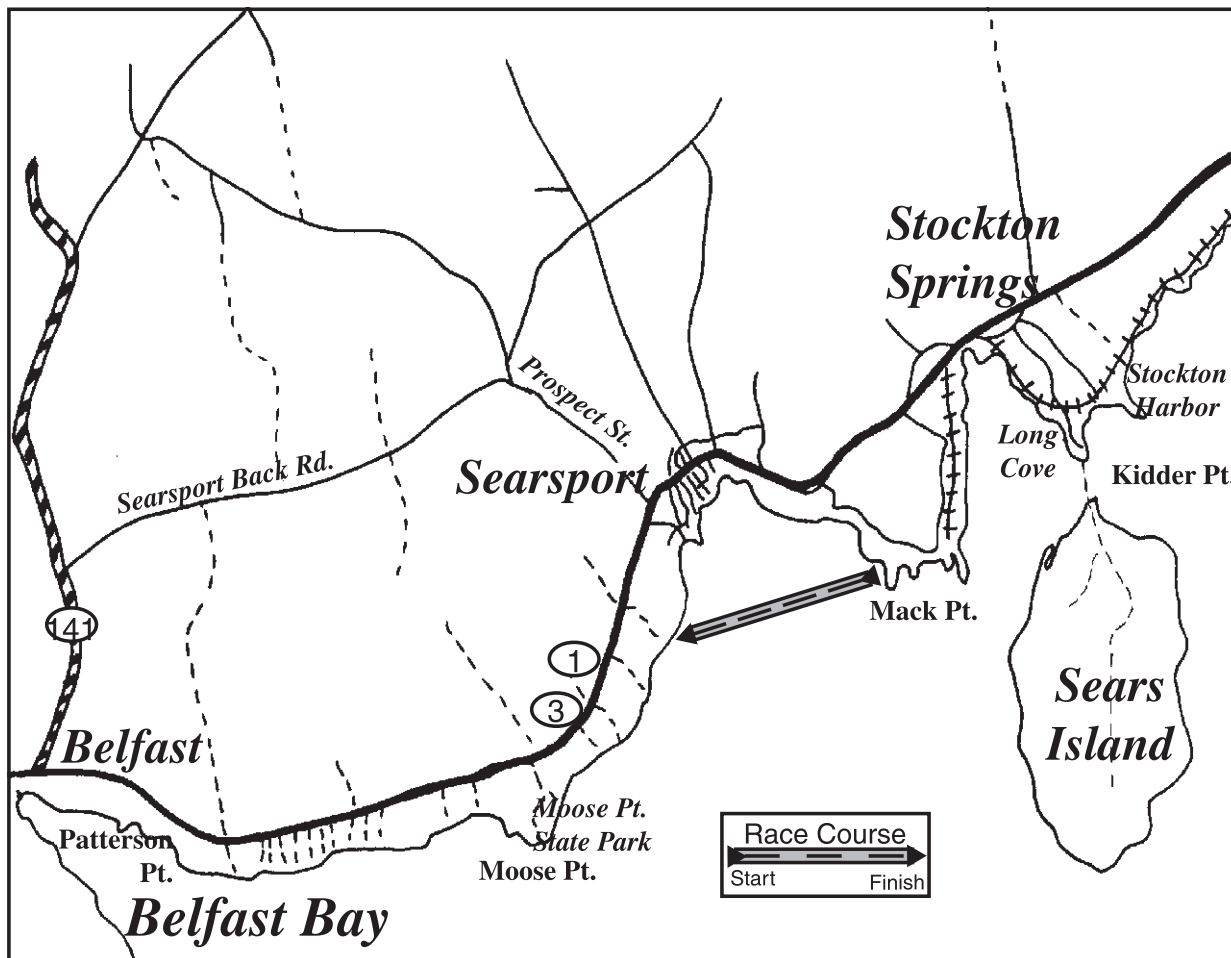
From points north and south: Route 1 goes straight through the heart of Searsport village. Shore access is marked on the side streets throughout town.

## ABOUT THE RACES:

Building on last year's success in moving these races from the summer circuit's season finale to midseason, Searsport will again be the opening stanza in a weekend double header with Stonington (July 13).

Searsport race committee chairman Keith Otis thinks the back-to-back dates are a natural. "It sure makes sense fuel-wise," he said.

This race typically gets high marks for organization and a high "fun factor." Plus, with registration, racing, post-event awards ceremonies, and race day concessions all centered around the town dock, visiting competitors don't have far to travel once they hit town.

Fuel service will be available from the town dock following the

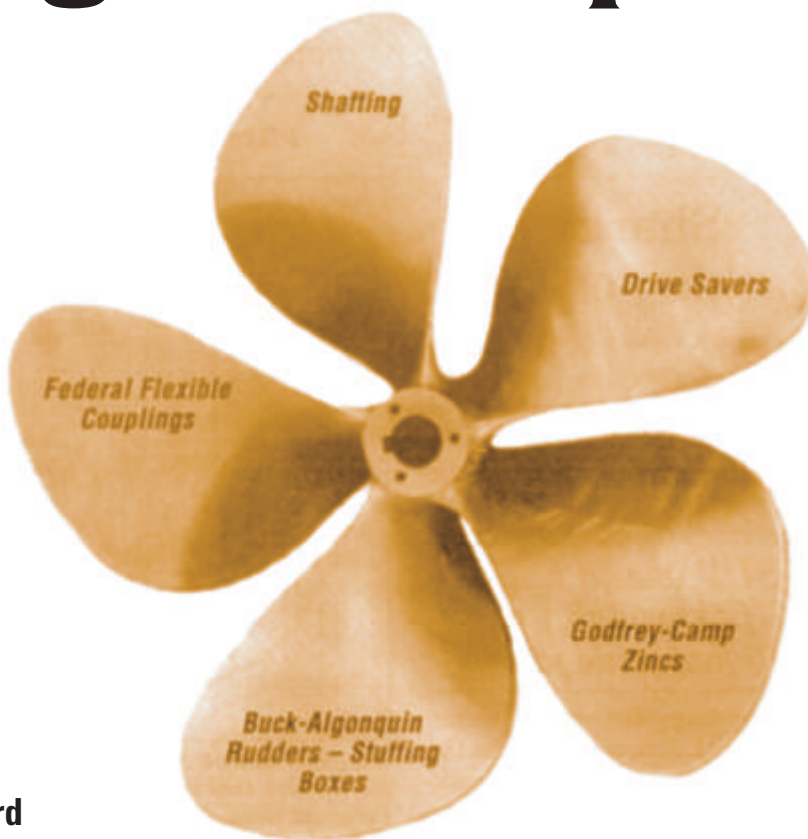
