DIRECTIONS:

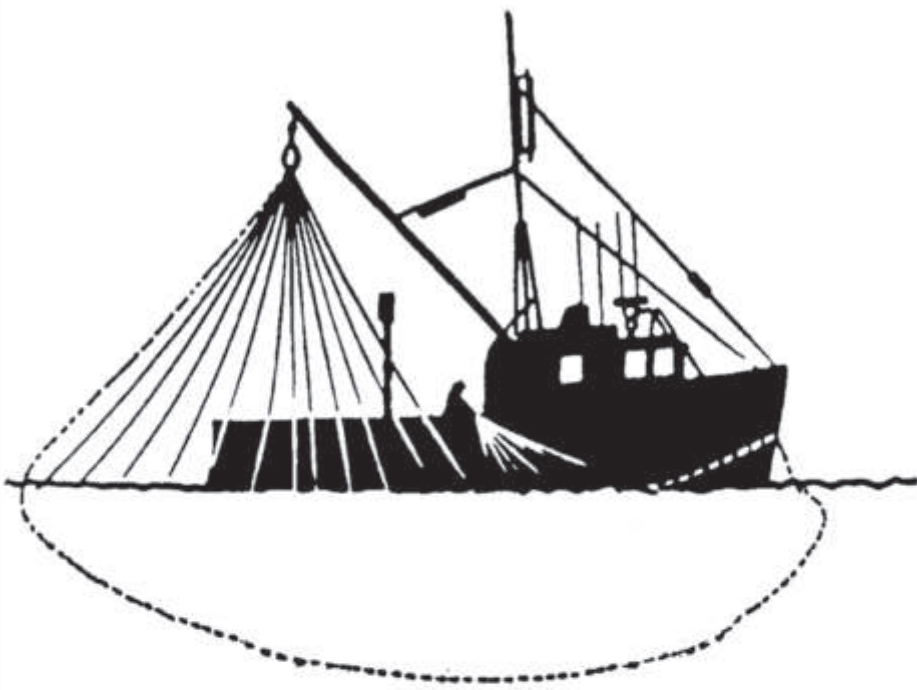
From points south: Route 1 north to Brunswick, turn onto Route 24 and then onto Route 123. Turn onto Basin Point Road and follow it to the shore.

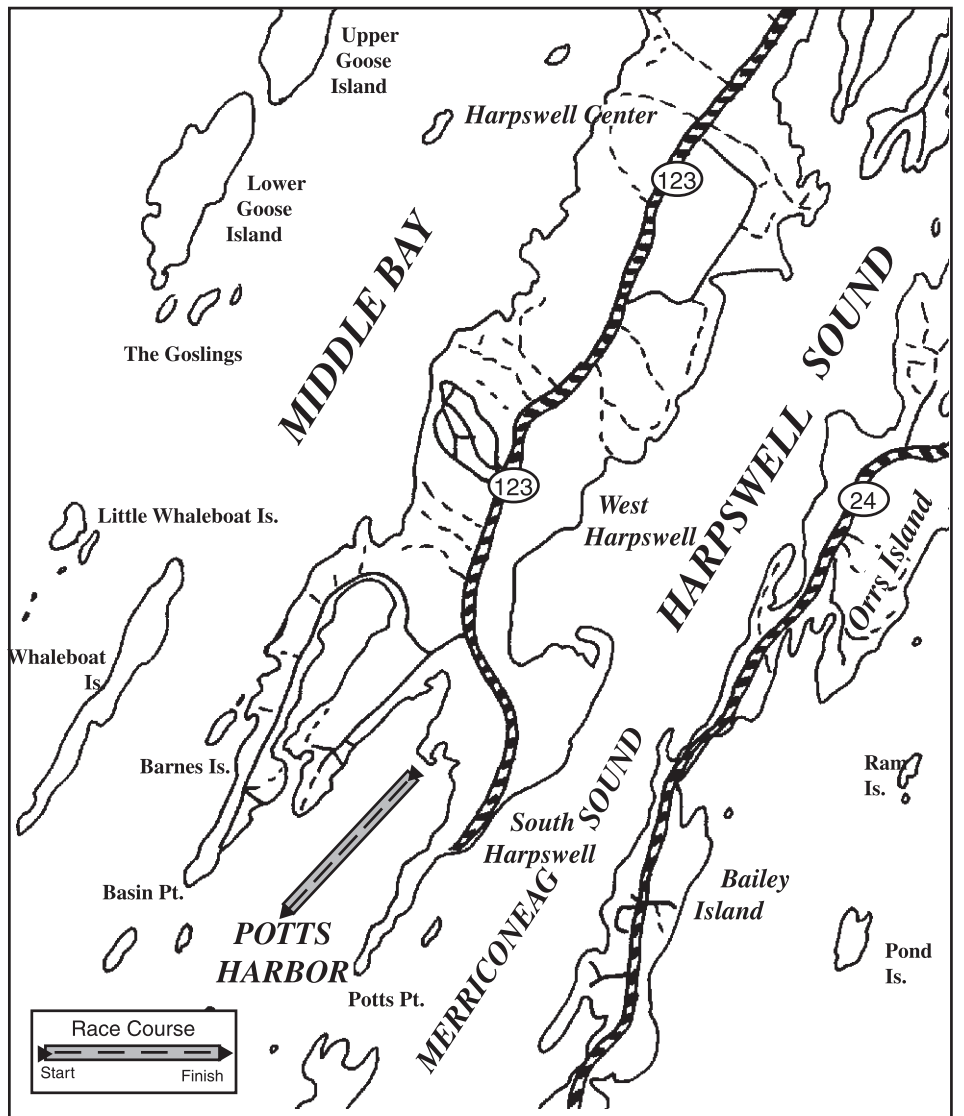
