WHERE TO WATCH FROM:

You really, really want to be aboard a boat to take in these races. Harpswell is unique in that all race-related activities, including pre-race registration, race judging, and post-race prize presentations are all done from aboard the committee float moored courseside in Potts Harbor. It is possible to get a distant view of the races from spots along Ash Point Road, down the end of Route 123 near Bibber Lobster, or out Basin Point Road. Please remember to be respectful of private property.

SERVICES FOR VISITING BOATS:

Moe's Market and The Vegetable Corner will be selling boat race hats, t-shirts, and sweatshirts. Look for concessions shoreside on the wharf across from the committee float, selling ice, cold drinks, burgers, and hot dogs on race day.

Also, Estee's Lobster House is a great spot for good food (and public restrooms).

Interstate Lobster offers a porta-john for public use and its docks are available for pick-up and drop-off of guests going to and from the committee float or other boats. But, absolutely no parking is available.

RELATED ACTIVITIES:

There are no specific activities planned to tie-in with this year's races. However, a wide range of activities and attractions are available to visitors who are in the Harpswell area. Harpswell is celebrating the town's 250th anniversary this year with several special activities and events.

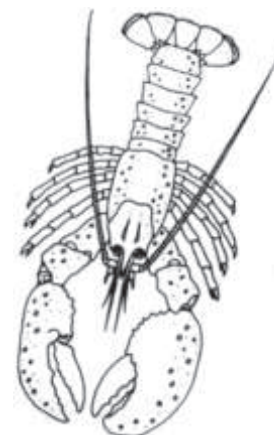
